How to Donate

Who Can Donate?

Expectant mothers of any age, who will undergo C-section birth delivery, can contribute their unused tissue for the creation of medical products that can help others.

Is it Safe?

The donation process poses no risk to either you or your baby, and there is no cost to you, your family or your insurance. If you choose to participate, together we can improve the quality of life for many patients undergoing surgery or wound treatment.

How Do I Begin?

To begin, discuss your decision to donate with your physician. Their office will contact Human Regenerative Technologies and we will arrange the rest.

You will be asked to sign a consent form to allow the acquisition of your placental tissue after your child is delivered and to answer questions regarding your medical and social history.

Your information will be used only for medical purposes in determining your eligibility for donation. All information you provide will be kept confidential according to patient confidentiality protocol.

Your donated placental tissue is processed and packaged in our state of the art facility.
